**ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTION No. 2003/14**

**IMPLEMENTING UNMIK REGULATION No. 2003/18 ON THE  
ESTABLISHMENT OF A CIVIL AVIATION REGULATORY OFFICE  
FOR KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/1 of 25 July 1999, as amended, on the Authority of the Interim Administration in Kosovo and sections 4, 5 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2003/18 of 13 June 2003 on the Establishment of a Civil Aviation Regulatory Office for Kosovo (hereinafter "CARO") and having consulted with the Government,

For the purpose of establishing a charge to be levied on passengers departing on a commercial flight from Kosovo,

Hereby issues the following Administrative Direction:

Section 1  
Passenger Service Charge

1.1 A Passenger Service Charge (hereinafter referred to as "the Charge") shall be levied on every person departing on a commercial flight from Kosovo in place of the previously levied airport departure fee, except if such a person is:

- (a) Under 2 years of age; or
- (b) A member of the airline crew on duty; or
- (c) Involuntarily re-routed by the airline to a destination in Kosovo.

1.2 The amount of the Charge shall be fifteen (15) euro, of which:

(a) 2.67 euro shall be allocated to CARO pursuant to UNMIK Regulation No. 2003/18 in order to cover its operational costs.

(b) 12.33 euro shall be allocated to cover the passenger terminal services at Pristina Airport that are provided by enterprises under the administration of the Kosovo Trust Agency pursuant to UNMIK Regulation No. 2002/12 of 13 June 2002.

The funds thus collected for allocation to CARO shall be placed in the Kosovo Consolidated Fund in coordination with the Ministry of Finance and Economy in a designated account under the control of Pillar IV.

1.3 The Charge shall be collected by airlines operating commercial flights departing from Kosovo at the point of sale of air tickets.

Section 2  
Entry into Force

This Administrative Direction shall enter into force on 1 July 2003.
