**ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTION NO. 2004/27**

**IMPLEMENTING UNMIK REGULATION NO. 2004/12  
ON ELECTIONS FOR THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under section 50 of United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 2004/12 of 5 May 2004 on Elections for the Assembly of Kosovo,

In conformity with the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Having regard to sections 7.2 and 9.2 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2004/12,

Taking into account UNMIK Administrative Direction No. 2004/25 of 7 October 2004 implementing UNMIK Regulation No. 2004/12,

Mindful of the exceptional circumstances of returns,

For the purpose of exceptionally enabling a certain category of individuals to participate in the 2004 Elections for the Assembly of Kosovo,

Noting the Decision of the Central Election Commission dated 23 October 2004 on the matter and the recommendation therein,

Hereby issues the following Administrative Direction:

Section 1  
Voting in the 2004 Elections

An individual who temporarily resided in the territory of Serbia and Montenegro other than Kosovo and returned to reestablish his/her residence in Kosovo after 6 August 2004, and who was previously registered as a voter for an election in Kosovo, may cast a conditional ballot in Kosovo in the 2004 Elections for the Assembly of Kosovo.

Section 2  
Entry into Force

The present Administrative Direction shall enter into force 23 October 2004.
