REGULATION NO. 2006/54 AMENDING UNMIK REGULATION NO. 2000/45 ON SELF-GOVERNMENT OF MUNICIPALITIES IN KOSOVO

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

Taking into account United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/1 of 25 July 1999, as amended, on the Authority of the Interim Administration in Kosovo, UNMIK Regulation No. 2002/11 of 19 June 2002 on the Municipal Elections in Kosovo, and UNMIK Determination No. 2006/10 of 16 June 2006 on the Postponement of Municipal Elections in Kosovo,

Having promulgated UNMIK Regulation No. 2000/45 of 11 August 2000,

For the purpose of amending section 10.3 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2000/45 in order to provide for an extension of the term of office of members of Municipal Assemblies elected in the 2002 Municipal Elections in conformity with Determination No. 2006/10 of 16 June 2006,

Hereby promulgates the following:

Section 1 Amendment

Section 10.3 of UNMIK Regulation No. 2000/45 is hereby revised to read:

10.3 The first term of office of members of the Municipal Assembly shall be two years. Thereafter, each term of office of members of the Municipal Assembly shall be four years, which may be exceptionally extended by the SRSG for the

prevailing policy considerations, following consultations with leaders of the PISG, and Political Entities represented in the Assembly of Kosovo.

Section 2 Entry into force

The present Regulation shall enter into force on 5 December 2006.
